February is the Month to Request the Drinking Water Bonus

From February 1st to 29th, it is possible to request the

drinking water bonus for expenses incurred in 2023 regarding the purchase and installation of filtering, mineralization, and cooling systems for improving water for domestic use. Let's see what it consists of and why it's worth applying.

What the Drinking Water Bonus Consists Of

The drinking water bonus was initially introduced for the 2021-2022 biennium, and subsequently extended until 2023 by the 2022 Budget Law. This incentive concerns the purchase and installation of filtering, mineralization, and cooling systems for improving water quality and water conservation.

The incentive provides a tax credit of 50% of the expenses incurred in 2023 for the purchase and installation of water purification equipment and devices, provided that the water is supplied by aqueducts.

The bonus is granted for the "purchase and" installation of systems for:

- filtering;
- mineralization;
- cooling and/or addition of food-grade carbon dioxide.

Those who can benefit from the bonus:

•individuals, but not in the exercise of an economic

activity on the private residential property;

• entrepreneurs, professionals, and non-commercial entities (including those belonging to the Third Sector and legally recognized religious entities) for the "property where the" commercial or institutional activity is carried out.

The maximum amount eligible for the incentive is 1,000 euros for each property for individuals and 5,000 euros for each property for businesses, freelance professionals, and non-commercial entities.

Which Condominium Expenses Can be Deducted?

It is possible to deduct condominium expenses for interventions carried out on the common parts of the building with percentages that may vary according to annual tax provisions. Here are some deductible interventions:

- facade renovation work;
- energy efficiency upgrades;
- waterproofing work on exposed areas (such as balconies or roofs);
- repair, replacement or simple routine maintenance of systems and common parts of the condominium;
- renovation and safety improvements of stairs and elevators;
- building renovation interventions;
- restoration to preserve parts subject to decay.

How to Claim Condominium Expenses

To request a partial deduction of expenses for 2022, simply

fill out this year's 730 form with the expenses incurred in 2022, entering them in "Section E — Charges and Expenses". However, it is necessary for the administrator to communicate them to the Agenzia delle Entrate through a document that reports the individual interventions carried out and the relative quotas attributed to each condominium owner. The document must be sent exclusively electronically.

Subsequently, the Agenzia delle Entrate will include the eligible deductions in the pre-compiled 730 form of the individual taxpayer.

Who Can Benefit from Condominium Expense Deductions?

Property owners have the right to benefit from deductions on condominium expenses in proportion to the shares expressed in the millennial tables. Even those who have a VAT number and have a home office can deduct 50% of condominium expenses, utilities, and rent, but only if they fall under the ordinary regime and not the flat-rate regime.

You can access the benefits from the moment the expenses have been paid by the condominium administrator, with payment completed within the year and within the deadlines for filing the tax return. In general, it is possible to benefit from condominium expense deductions over a period of ten years.

Resto al Sud is an incentive aimed at entrepreneurs aged between 18 and 55, residing in the southern regions (Abruzzo, Basilicata, Calabria, Campania, Molise, Puglia, Sardinia and Sicily) and in specific areas of Central Italy affected by seismic events. The program finances up to 100% of eligible expenses, with a 50% non-repayable grant and a zero-interest loan for the remaining 50%. The maximum amount that can be financed is 50,000 euros for individual applicants and up to 200,000 euros for companies composed of four partners. Applications are evaluated in chronological order of arrival, without preset deadlines.
