

First home loan buyers: changes and who can benefit from them

A new decree is being prepared by the Draghi government aimed at under 36's. We are talking about the draft of the "Sostegni bis" decree regarding the **first home loan for young people**, which would offer the possibility for young people under 36 to start the procedures to take out a mortgage without paying an advance and without the need for a guarantor. As with [the first home loan Gasparrini Fund](#), the State will guarantee mortgage applicants, but with the **100% capital guarantee**

First home loan: how it works and who can apply

The new legislation for **first home tax breaks** would enter a broader program that *"looks to the next generation"*, as premier Draghi underlined during the illustration in the Recovery Plan. *"We are one of the countries with the lowest fertility in Europe: fewer than 1.3 children per woman against almost 1.6 for the EU average. To enable our young people to form a family, we must respond to three of their requests: adequate welfare, a home and a secure job. In addition to the nursery school plan, which I have already talked about, young people benefit from measures for social infrastructure and social housing "...*

Young people under 36 can access the guarantee fund, including those who do not have a permanent employment contract and want to buy their first property. The State will guarantee for a

maximum cap of € 250,000 on deeds stipulated to the 31 December 2022

Prestigious homes and the following cadastral categories are excluded from the concessions:

- • A1 – stately homes,
- • A8 – dwellings in villas,
- A9 – castles and palaces of outstanding artistic and historical value.

The reliefs include the exemption from registration tax, the mortgage and land registry tax and the reimbursement of the VAT paid for the transaction.

The consequences of the first home subsidies on the real estate market

In this perspective, the **benefits for young adults** who want to buy their first home see a 100% state guarantee. A new encouraging forecast for young families who see easier access to the **first home guarantee fund**, unlike that provided for in the 2019 Growth Decree, this provides a guarantee by the State of 100% of the capital, together with the other reliefs listed above.

If 210,000 applications were registered with the Guarantee Fund established in 2014 (of which 60% from young people under the age of 35) it can be assumed that, by facilitating access to the fund, the applications will be substantial. A further input for the real estate market which is opening up more and more to that socio-demographic group that feels the need to buy a house to realize the desire to create a family, but is

hampered by working and contractual conditions that do not facilitate the access to the mortgage.

Home expense management: 3 tricks to limit your expenses

Keeping household expenses under control, especially in a period like this, is essential to better manage your family

economy and make ends meet at the end of the month. To carry out a **correct management of home expenses**, these few tricks are enough to make a difference by the end of the month.

Home expense management: focusing on to how you heat your house

Let's start with warming-up. To keep the house warm it's not necessary to turn on the heaters and get the temperature to tropical levels, but it's better to keep a constant temperature between 18 ° and 20 ° avoiding heat loss. To do this, there are some easy tricks to use, let's take a look.

If you leave the house in the morning and come back in the evening, you certainly cannot keep the heaters on while you are not at home. A system to control the heating is the Chronothermostat, a device that allows you to adjust the temperature in the house during the different times of the day or night. Unlike the thermostat, the Chronothermostat allows you to set two types of temperatures: comfort and reduction. When you are away from home it is best set to the "reduction" mode, in order to find a warm and comfortable environment, without unnecessary waste. Furthermore, the Chronothermostat can also be connected to portable devices such as a tablet or Smartphone so as to have control remotely.

If you have a fireplace in your home, consider insulating it when it is not in use. All you need is a thermal insulating panel that can be found on the market at an affordable price, or a chimney balloon to be inserted in the flue to prevent the heat from being dispersed outside. In regards to window shutters, be careful of the seal on the roller shutter boxes placed on the windows.

Another simple action, which may seem insignificant, is not to block the radiators with chairs or other furniture so as not to obstruct the heat emission. Also beware of drafts, try to limit them by placing self-adhesive seals on the doors and windows. With these small, but fundamental precautions, you can keep your home heating costs under control.

Lower your monthly home expenses by paying attention to the appliances you buy

One of the expenses that mostly affects the family budget is the electricity bill. Also in this case it is possible to limit waste by paying attention to appliances we normally underestimate.

Let's start with the choice of appliances. If you need to buy them, remember that by opting for the energy efficiency class A, A ++ or A +++, you will spend a little more initially, but the expense will be sufficiently reduced over time with "cheaper" bills. Think that a class A refrigerator brings electricity saving of 24% on the electricity bill.

Now we come to a daily action that will bring down your household expenses: do not keep appliances on stand-by. We assume that when you go to sleep you let the television turn off by itself? You may not know that turning off the TV or computer will save you 16% on your bill.

Use family budget apps to organize

Leave the classic way of noting expenses. You can now use specific apps to keep the family and domestic budget under control. Here are some popular expense management apps: Monefy, Expensify and iSpesa. These applications replace common notebooks and are certainly more practical and functional, as it is possible to synchronize budget planners with other devices to share the findings with the people who live with you. 2021 water bonus: who is it for and how to obtain it?

In one of our articles we recommended [3 ways to limit the costs](#) of household utilities. Today we are talking about another **saving opportunity** that comes directly from the State.

We are talking about the 2021 water bonus for which a contribution of €1,000 is envisaged for individuals, and €5,000 for commercial establishments, to be used by 31 December 2021. the 2021 Budget Law includes a bonus which was introduced on January 1 of this year. But let's see specifically what it is and who can use it.

Who can benefit from the water bonus?

The **water bonus 2021**, found in article 1 from paragraphs 61 to 65, provides €1,000 *“for interventions to replace ceramic sanitary basins with new reduced-drain equipment and sanitary taps, shower heads and existing shower columns with new appliances to limit the water flow, in existing buildings, parts of existing buildings or single real estate units”* as published in the Official Gazette.

Those who want to replace water flow devices with others that save water resources can benefit from the water bonus. The bonus is valid for:

- • the supply and installation of ceramic sanitary basins with a maximum discharge volume equal to or less than 6 litres and related discharge systems, including connected plumbing and masonry work, and the dismantling and disposal of existing systems,
- • the supply and installation of taps and mixers in bathrooms and kitchens, devices for controlling the flow of water with a flow rate equal to or less than 6 litres per minute, and shower heads and shower columns with water flow values equal to or less than 9 litres per minute, including any connected plumbing and masonry work and the dismantling and disposal of pre-existing systems.

A fundamental requirement to benefit from the 2021 water bonus is to be an Italian resident.

How much allowance is with the 2021 water bonus?

With the **water bonus**, for individuals it is possible to recover 50% of the expenses incurred, therefore €500 for a maximum of €1,000 of expenditure, while for commercial activities it goes up to €2,500 for a maximum of €5,000 of expenses.

How to apply for the 2021 water bonus?

As stated on the website of the Revenue Agency or Agenzia delle Entrate: *“The methods for obtaining the bonus will be defined by a decree of the Environmental Minister and the protection of the territory and the sea and to be issued within 60 days of the entry into force of the law of the 2021 budget”*.

Smart working: 4 tips to organize your home office

Are you smart working and have transferred your office to your home?□

Do you want to organize documents that you leave scattered on the desk, or do you want to change the arrangement of the furniture to improve your working conditions?

Then let us offer you some advice!

Choosing the room to work in...

Working at home, sometimes, may not give the same results than if you were in the office. The choice of the room and where to position yourself is very important to keep concentration high and be productive. Here are 3 simple tips for you.

- Try to create your own workspace. Opt for the room that can hold all the tools and devices you need, so you don't have to go back and forth around the house and waste time.
- If possible, go to a room other than the one where you

sleep. By moving to another room, used as an office, you prepare yourself psychologically to face your commitments methodically and professionally.

- Wall colours are also important. If the rooms in the house are painted in different shades, then choose one according to the work you're doing. If your work is a creative, opt for blue shades. If you do a job for which calmness and relaxation are important, then your colour is green.

How to position the desktop or workstation in relation to the light

- Choosing the room, let's see how to position the desk with the computer in relation to the light.
- Neither windows should be located in front of nor behind the desktop, so as to avoid those annoying reflections on the computer screen that disturb the view.
- The light must be parallel to the screen. If this is not possible, it is good to darken the window with blinds or something similar.
- Also pay attention to the desk on which the computer is placed and to the walls surrounding your work corner. Opt for non-glossy furniture and paints since the combination of these two elements can cause refraction effects.

How to arrange lighting devices

Now let's focus on the luminous devices and their arrangement to favour a correct working condition, in the office as well as at home. First of all, remember that in a work environment

there should always be the right balance between artificial and natural light. Having said that, here are some tips for carefully choosing lamps, spotlights, LEDs and other light sources.

- The light source must be warm, never cold, and must not exceed a colour temperature of 3,000 K.
- Opt for energy saving bulbs so your bills won't go through the roof.
- Do not place the desktop workstations under a direct light source – be it a window in the ceiling, lamps or spotlights placed directly above or overhead and be sure not to place them centrally in the room.
- Move the computer away from you about 50-70 cm and adjust the brightness of the monitor so that it does not strain your eyes.

How to arrange shelves to store documents

Let's imagine that you had to bring a lot of documents home to avoid going out as much as possible, and now you are desperate because you don't know how to organize them. Follow these tips to have a clear workspace, keep an empty desk and fill the shelves.

- The first advice is to sort the documents into groups and subgroups. For example: office bills (group), water, gas, electricity (subgroup). This way finding the "key" folder and subfolders will be much easier.
- To store your suppliers' invoices, use a single large folder. If you have one with rings then you can appoint each transparent sheet with a different supplier. If you have simple folders, use paper folders and paperclips to

group them.

- Use different coloured folders and give each one a connotation, so it will be easier and faster to distinguish the content. For example: the folder with the documents to bring to the accountant blue, your projects orange, invoices red and so on.
